

J. E. DOHERTY, ST. LOUIS BUYER FOR A. & P., DIES

John Edward Doherty, head buyer of the St. Louis office of the Great Atlantic & Pacific Tea Co., 4507 Scott avenue, who died of a brain tumor yesterday at his home, 7343 Lindell boulevard, University City, will be buried tomorrow in Chicago, his birthplace. The body will be at the Lawrence M. Mullen Undertaking Parlors, 5165 Delmar boulevard, until 10 a. m. tomorrow. Mr. Doherty had been ill about five months.

He was 42 years old and had been an employe of the A. & P. for twenty-two years, having been made head buyer here in 1927.

Surviving are his wife, the former Miss Myrtle Chopp, and two sons, John, Jr. and Thomas Doherty.
